


# **Unit 1: Introduction to the Short Vowels**

In this lesson, we will learn the names of the short vowels.


There are three short vowels in Arabic.

They are:




#### Name the Short Vowel




#### Write On! - Write the Short Vowels


Let's practice writing the short vowels.

#### Other Fun Ways to Learn


If you are still having trouble with the names of the short vowels, try these activities:



Keep playing games and activities like these until you know the names of the short vowels before moving on to the next page.


