### TRANSITIVE VERBS

Most transitive verbs need one object

One which is complete with the doer of the action.

### INTRANSITIVE VERBS

أَفْعَالُ الْإِلَازِمِ

كَرَّمَ زَيْدٌ

But there are some verbs that require two objects

حَسِبَ زَيْدٌ بَكْرًا غَنِيًّا
