Abu Dharr reported: The Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, said, "Allah Almighty said: O My servants, I have forbidden injustice for Myself, and I have forbidden it among you, so do not oppress one another. O My servants, all of you are astray except for those I have guided, so seek guidance from Me and I shall guide you.... O My servants, it is only your deeds that I record and then recompense for you. Let him who finds good praise Allah, and let him who finds something else blame no one but himself."



أسرَى ج أسير (ء س ر)

This word is used for shackles.

Here is refers to prisoners.

يُثْخِنَ (ث خ ن)

It means to lift something to estimate it's weight. It is not easy to move a heavy object.

Here it is used for intense bloodshed and massacre.

كتكث

kataba/yaktubu is to write. Kitaab is anything that is written.

Also used for a decree, a rule, a hukm

لَّوْلَا كِتَابٌ مِّنَ ٱللَّهِ سَبَقَ لَمَسَّكُمْ فِيمَا أَخَذْتُمْ عَذَابٌ عَظِيمٌ ﴿ ٦٨﴾

The kitaab here refers to Allah swt's hukm, or law of the lawfulness of accepting ransom. In surah Muhammad the believers are told that they are allowed to accept the ransom. This instruction had not been given yet. They had decided themselves

Secondly it is said that kitaab refers to the decision of Allah swt that he would not punish those who participated in Badr [for taking ransom from prisoners]

Some say that kitaab refers to Allah swt's law that he doesn't punish a people without a hukm.

The Prophet sas said that he was given five things that wasn't given to any Prophet before: one of these was that the war booty was made lawful to him and it was not made lawful to any before.


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








Summary by Sis Tayymiah Zubair
