وَتَشْتَكِي إِلَى اللَّهِ and complains to Allah.

وَاللَّهُ يَسْمَعُ تَحَاوُرَكُمَا And Allah hears the argument between you both.

إِنَّ اللَّهَ سَمِيعٌ بَصِيرٌ Verily, Allah is All-Hearer, All-Seer.

## Reason for revealing this Surah:

In the narration that Ibn Abi Hatim collected, A'ishah said, "Blessed is He, Whose hearing has encompassed all things. I heard what Khawlah bint Tha'labah said while some of it I could not hear. She was complaining to Allah's Messenger about her husband. She said, 'O Allah's Messenger! He spent my wealth, exhausted my youth and my womb bore abundantly for him. When I became old, unable to bear children, he pronounced the Zihar on me!

O Allah! I complain to you.'

Soon after, Jibril brought down this Ayah,

(Indeed, Allah has heard the statement of her that disputes with you concerning her husband),"

She added, "Her husband was Aws bin As-Samit."
