

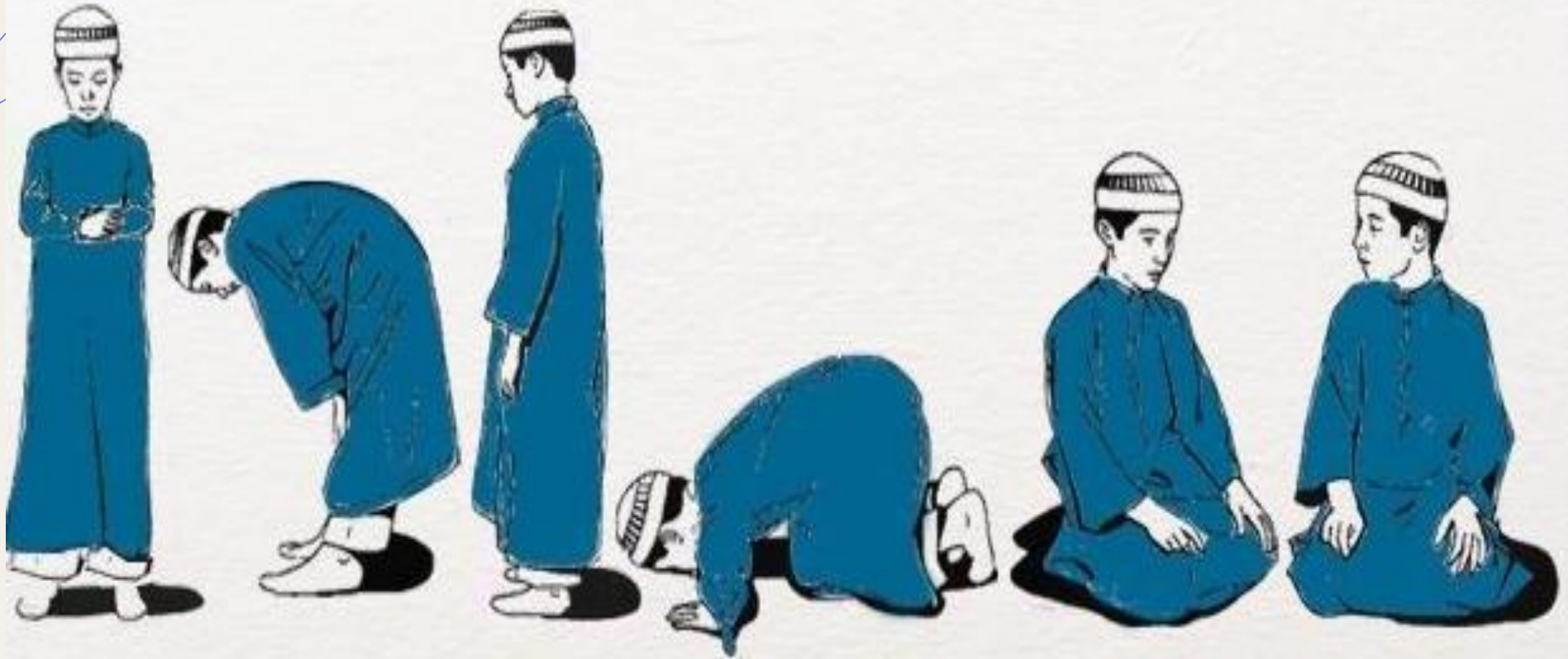

Definition of الصلاة

- + **Linguistic Meaning** of الصلاة = الدعاء
- + **Terminology Meaning** of الصلاة = A worship, combination of words and deeds, which begin with Takbeer and end at Tasleem

Benefit #1

Ibn 'Umar reported:

While we said prayer with the Messenger of Allah (s.a.w), one among the people said: Allah is truly Great, praise be to Allah in abundance. Glory be to Allah in the morning and the evening. The Messenger of Allah (s.a.w) said: Who uttered such and such a word? A person among the people said: It is I, Messenger of Allah (who have recited these words). He (s.a.w) said: It (its utterance) surprised me, **for the doors of heaven were opened for it.** 'Ibn Umar said: I have not abandoned them (these words) since I heard the Messenger of Allah (s.a.w) saying this.

It was narrated from Abdullah bin Umar that:

A man stood behind the Prophet of Allah (ﷺ) and said: "Allahu Akbaru kabira wal-hamdu Lillahi kathira, wa subhan-Allahi bukratan was asila (Allah is Most Great and much praise be to Allah and glorified be Allah at the beginning and end of the day)." The Prophet of Allah (ﷺ) said: "Who spoke these words?" A man said: "I did, O Prophet of Allah (SWT)." He said: **"Twelve angels rushed (to take them up)."**

Narrated Abu Sa'id al-Khudri: When the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) got up to pray at night (for tahajjud prayer) he uttered the takbir and then said: "**Glory be to Thee, O Allah,**" and "**Praise be to Thee**" and "**Blessed is Thy name,**" and "**Exalted is Thy greatness.**" He then said: "**There is no god but Allah**" **three times**; he then said: "**Allah is altogether great**" **three times**: "**I seek refuge in Allah, All-Hearing and All-Knowing from the accursed devil, from his evil suggestion (hamz), from his puffing up (nafkh), and from his spitting (nafth)**" He then recited (the Qur'an)."

Reference

Narrated Abu Huraira:

Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) used to keep silent between the Takbir and the recitation of Qur'an and that interval of silence used to be a short one. I said to the Prophet (ﷺ) "May my parents be sacrificed for you! What do you say in the pause between Takbir and recitation?"

The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "I say, 'Allahumma, baa'id baini wa baina khatayaya kama baa'adta baina l-mashriqi wa l-maghrib. Allahumma, naqqini min khatayaya kama yunaqqa th-thawbu l-abyadu mina d-danas. Allahumma, ighsil khatayaya bi l-maa'i wa th-thalji wa l-barad (O Allah! Set me apart from my sins (faults) as the East and West are set apart from each other and clean me from sins as a white garment is cleaned of dirt (after thorough washing). O Allah! Wash off my sins with water, snow and hail.)"

Reference

Abu Sa'eed Al Khudri narrated:

When Allah's Messenger stood for Salat during the night, he would say the Takbir (Allahu Akbar), then say: (Subhanaka Allahumma wa bihamdika wa Tabarakasmuka wa Ta'ala Jadduka wa la ilaha ghairuk.) 'Glorious You are O Allah, and with Your praise, and blessed is Your Name, and exalted is Your majesty, and none has the right to be worshipped but You' Then he would say: .)" 'Allah is undoubtedly the greatest.' (Allahu Akbaru Kabira). Then he would say: (A'udhu Bilahi As-Sami'il-Alimi min Ash-Shaitanir-Rajimi, min Hamzihi Wa Nafkhihi wa Nafthihi 'I seek refuge in Allah the All-Hearing, the All-Knowing, from the cursed Shaitan, from his madness, his arrogance, and his poetry.'

How to stop waswas in salah?

Uthman b. Abu al-'As reported that he came to Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) and said: Allah's Messenger, the Satan intervenes between me and my prayer and my reciting of the Qur'an and he confounds me. Thereupon Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said: That is (the doing of a) Satan (devil) who is known as **Khinzib**, and when you perceive its effect, seek refuge with Allah from it and spit three times to your left. I did that and Allah dispelled that from me.

If you have doubt in your salah

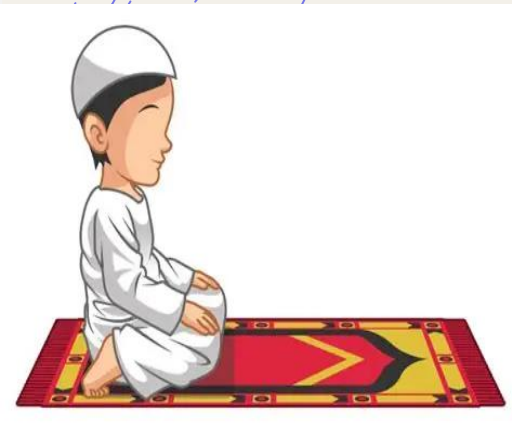
The Prophet (ﷺ) said: "If one of you is not sure about his prayer, let him forget about what he is unsure of and complete his prayer on the basis of what he is sure of. When he is sure that he has completed it, let him prostrate twice while he is sitting. Then if he has prayed five (rak'ahs), they (**the two prostrations**) will make his prayer even-numbered, and if he had prayed four, **they will annoy and humiliate the shaitan.**"

Only count the rakahs you have certainty in

- + Complete your salah according to the rakahs you are certain in
- + Then perform Sajdah al Sahw (sajdah of forgetfulness)

Abdullah ibn Abbas (رضي الله تعالى عنه) narrated that the Prophet (صلى الله عليه وآله وسلم) named the two prostrations of forgetfulness **disgraceful** for the devil.

Narrated 'Ubada bin As-Samit:

The surah which is recited the most in a day

- +Daily 5 Salahs
- +Just in the Fard Salah
- +There are 17 Fard Rakahs in total
- +We Recite Surah Fatihah 17 times, at least, each day

When standing behind the Imam in Salah

Abu Huraira reported:

The Apostle of Allah (ﷺ) said: If anyone observes prayer in which he does not recite Umm al-Qur'an, It is deficient [he said this three times] and not complete.

It was said to Abu Huraira: At times we are behind the Imam.

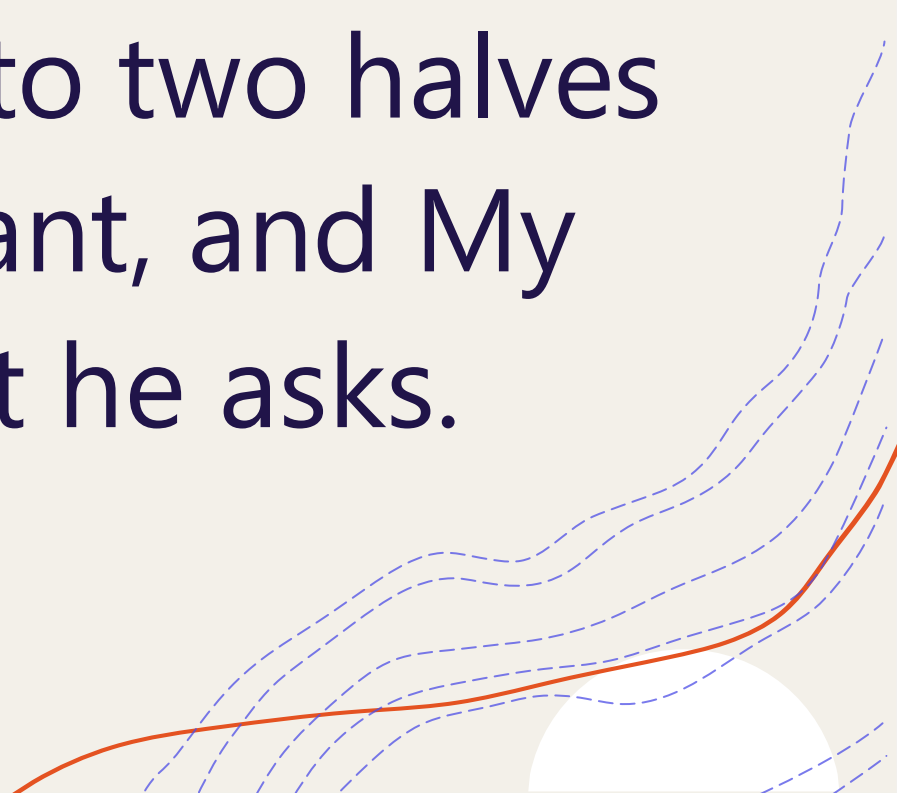
He said: **Recite it inwardly,**

for he had heard the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) declare that Allah the Exalted had said...

- Then, when he (**the worshipper**) says: Guide us to the straight path, the path of those to whom Thou hast been Gracious not of those who have incurred Thy displeasure, nor of those who have gone astray,
- He (**Allah**) says: This is for My servant, and My servant will receive what he asks for.

Tilawah of Surah Fatihah

It is narrated on the authority of Ibn Abi Malikah that someone asked Umm Salamah (may Allah be pleased with her) about the recitation of the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him). She said: "The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) used to recite the Qur'an **pausing at each verse.**" Then she **recited the first three verses of Surah Fatiha, pausing after each verse.**

Etiquette of making dua'a

(as taught in Surah Fatihah)

- +Praise Allah before making your dua
- +Call Allah (SWT) by His Names and Attributes, use them as a means/wasilah to get your dua answered (by saying Ar Rahman, ar Raheem)
- +Make dua to Allah (SWT) with Sincerity and Humbleness (iyyaka na'budu wa iyyaka nastaieen)
- +Then, ask for your needs/make your dua
